

Route from Tunbridge Wells

Leave The Pantiles by Swan Passage opposite the bandstand (up steps).
 Go along Major Yorks Road for 50m then turn left along track by entrance to car park.
 Pass through wooden posts then forward onto path along grassy track.
 This track is a right of way for cyclists. (Do not use the surfaced path).
 Forward through wooden posts into unsurfaced road (Cabbage Stalk Lane).
 Down hill (CARE!!) and forward onto surfaced road to cross over railway
 and pass High Rocks.

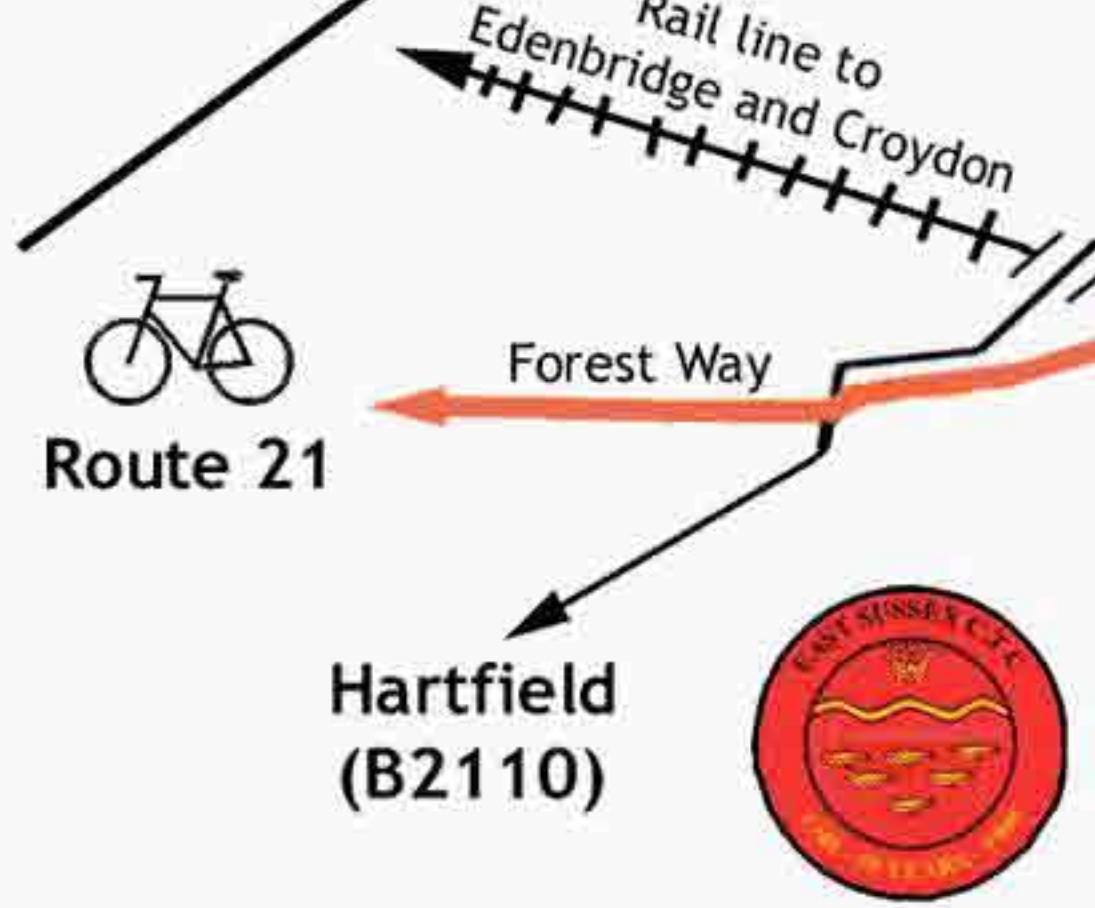
Immediately after junction with Eridge Road bear left along track
 then path to cross railway.

Left into Corseley Road to pass church and school.
 Road bears right then sharp left down hill. (Care!!)

At bottom of hill turn right onto Forest Way
 Cycleway (Route 21) for Hartfield, Forest Row,
 East Grinstead and Three Bridges.

Continue forward on Cycle Route 21
 for Eridge Station and Heathfield
 where you join the Cuckoo Trail to
 Hailsham and Eastbourne.

(Approx. 500 metres before you
 reach Eridge Station there is a
 road on the right which is a
 bridleway leading to
 Crowborough via
 Motts Farm,
 Orznash Farm
 and Gillridge
 Farm.)

Route from Groombridge

From the start of the
 Forest Way go up the hill
 (Corseley Road) to pass school
 and church. After passing Lynwood
 on your right turn sharp right to pass
 Bowls Club and cross railway. Forward
 on path, turn right onto road and bear left
 at junction with Eridge Road into Station Road.
 Fork left (signpost High Rocks and Tunbridge Wells)
 and go past High Rocks to cross railway. Continue to
 the Tunbridge Wells town sign where go straight on into
 Cabbage Stalk Lane (unsurfaced). Up hill to wooden posts
 where forward along the left of two grassy tracks. Pass through
 wooden posts and continue to Major Yorks Road by car park where
 turn right to the Pantiles.
